

Winter Seasonal Brews

#1 Bells Winter White Ale - 5.0% abv - Belgian Wheat

Taking its cues from Belgian-style white ales, Bell's Winter White Ale offers a lighter yet abundantly flavorful alternative to the traditional heavy winter warmers.

Fermented with a Belgian ale yeast, this blend of barley & wheat malts yields a mixture of clove and fruity aromas, all without the use of any spices. Deliberately brewed to retain a cloudy appearance, Bell's Winter White Ale is a beer for embracing winter. 16oz \$6.5

#2 Ommegang Adoration (Barrel Aged) - 10% abv - Belgian Dark Strong

Aged in Buffalo Trace barrels. Brewed in the authentic style of Belgian winter, or noel beer, is strong dark, malty and assertively spiced. Even with a strong abv, this beer is well balanced and not at all hot or fiery. The dark malts give it a lush, malty flavor and aromas, strongly complemented by the five spices, including coriander, cumin, mace, cardamom and grains of paradise. 12oz \$9.5

#3 Allagash Map 40 - 7.5%abv - Coffee Stout

Belgian style stout blended with cold-brewed coffee from speckled Ax, a local coffee roaster. 12oz \$8.5

#4 Thin Man Bliss - 8.0% abv - Imperial IPA

Find bliss in the most unexpected places with this juicy Double IPA from the Buffalo native: Thin Man Brewery. 16oz \$8.5

#5 Brix City Sixes and Sevens - 5.0% abv - English Brown Ale

Indulge in this take on a classic style. This brew drinks crisp and clean. Which makes it a perfect beer for cool weather. With bittersweet notes of light coffee and hazelnut with a dusting of cocoa powder. 16oz Draft \$7.5

#6 Von Trapp Bohemian Pilsner - 5.4% abv - Czech Pilsner

Spicy, citrus peel botanicals combine with a dry, peppery finish to create a truly thirst-quenching lager. A beer that demands you take more than one sip. 12oz \$6.5

#7 Sam Adams Mountain Berry Ale - 3.8% abv - Fruit Beer

This light ale is aged on raspberries and blackberries grown in the Pacific Northwest. The bright fruit notes, refreshingly light body, and sticking color and aroma make this the perfect brew for changing it up! 12oz \$6.5

#8 St Feuillien Tripel - 8.5% abv - Belgian Tripel

Sparkling orangish-golden in color with a brilliant white foam. Highly aromatic with vivid hop resins leaping out of the glass. The flavor is bright, leanly malty, spicy and hoppy. A generous amount of carbonation makes for a full mouthfeel as well as mountains of pillowy foam 12oz \$11.0

Winter Hop Brews

1 Firestone Walker Double Jack - 9.5% abv - Imperial IPA

A dangerously drinkable Double IPA. Double Jack opens up with bright grapefruit and tangerine American hop aromas, then followed by the essence of blue basil and pine. A sturdy pale and crystal malt backbone brings balance to high hop intensity. Complex and aggressively hopped, and flawlessly balanced. 12oz \$6.5

#2 2SP Up & Out - 6.0% abv - IPA

A very juicy IPA. It's got a big aroma, moderately bitter, and is earthy with notes of stone fruit, berry, & citrus. Brewed with Simcoe, Cascade and Mosaic hops. 16oz \$8.5

Winter Draft Brews

1 Founders Canadian Breakfast Stout - 11.6% abv - Imperial Stout

An imperial stout brewed with a blend of coffees and imported chocolates, then aged in spent bourbon barrels that have most recently been aging pure Michigan maple syrup. 8oz \$9.5

#2 Guinness Over the Moon - 5.3% abv - Milk Stout

Over the Moon Milk Stout has notes of caramel, chocolate, and a light roastiness that might remind some people of Guinness' historic stouts. However it finishes with a sweetness characteristic of milk stouts, which makes this beer approachable and exciting. pint \$7.5

#3 Sierra Nevada 40th Anniversary - 6.7% abv - Pale Ale

Hop forward beer was not popular when Sierra Nevada started brewing in 1980, but they decided to start with something distinctive. It's been 40 years and they continue to brew what they love! This beer showcase the bold flavors and aromas of a classic West Coast IPA: intense pine and citrus with a deep gold color and slight caramel sweetness. pint \$6.5
